

Skill Development through Employability Programmes @ GTT

To enhance the employability skills of students, Global Talent Track foundation in association with Barclays conducted a training session in Jagran College of Arts, Science and Commerce from 3rd-11th Jan, 2022. The college collaborated with GTTF to conduct 8 days training session on the topic **“BARCLAYS LIFE SKILLS”**. Under the able mentorship of Alka Wahani and Nikita Baheti training sessions were conducted covering following areas: 1) Communication 2) Teamwork 3) Time management 4) Critical thinking 5) Mind Map 6) Digital Literacy 7) Positive attitude 8) Self-motivation 9) Leadership 10) Work ethics 11) Dependability 12) Adaptability 13) Negotiations 14) Interview techniques. In addition to this each student was given an opportunity to appear for a mock interview on Job Description of his/her choice. Few case studies were also discussed where students came up with very effective solutions.

Simultaneously training session was conducted for BCA First- and Second-year students on the topic **“Python Level Basic to Advance”**. Students had the opportunity to practice their theoretical concepts on live projects which enabled them to develop the real-life experience and understand the technicalities required. To make the session interesting various activities were also conducted to have active participation of students. Overall, 294 students were benefited from the training session. The 8 days training session was full of knowledge and interesting facts through which were able to establish a good connect with the training program and successfully learnt useful skills
