1. Registration for B.A. I, B.Com. I, B.Sc. I, B.B.A. I, B.C.A. I and M.Com I will start from 12th June, 2020. Duly filled forms should be submitted within a week from the date of issue.
2. The college prospectus containing the admission form shall be available to applicants or their guardians from the college office at **620, W-Block, Saket Nagar, Kanpur** on the payment of **Rs. 200/-** in cash.
3. Self attested photocopies countersigned by parents/guardians, of all the previous marks sheets, original copies of migration and transfer certificates must be attached with the admission form. Three photographs are to be submitted with the admission form. Parents/Guardians have to submit their income certificate also.
4. Admission will be on the merit basis subject to the approval of the Admission Committee. Merit list shall be displayed on the notice board.

However SC/ST Category Students may directly approach Principal for Admission.

5. Students who are selected for admission in B.Com, B.A., B.B.A., B.C.A. and B.Sc. first year are required to obtain WRN through CSJMU Website.
6. Admission in B.A. II and III year/ B.B.A. II and III year/ B.Com. II and III year / B.C.A II & III year/ B.Sc. II & III year and M.Com. II year will be on the basis of past performance, attendance and satisfactory behaviour during the previous year in the college.

Uniform

Withdrawal
