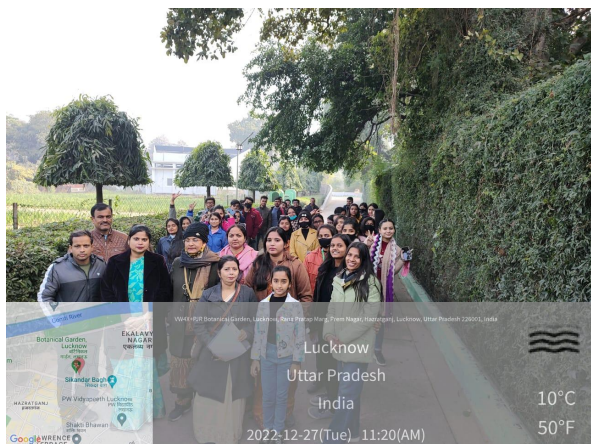


## Educational Trip to NBRI Lucknow, Botanical Garden
