Monuments are the grappling –irons that bind one generation to other. Ram Raj Temple and Orchha fort are the iconic landmarks in the town. On the banks of Betwa, Orchha Fort is a splendid specimen of Indian art and culture. It was built by Bundela Chief Rudra Pratap Singh in 1501 AD. This fort further inspired Lutyens in designing the architecture and structure of New Delhi. Students with their faculty understood the nuances and features of these Historical Monuments.
