S. No	FEEDBACK	ACTION TAKEN
1.	Students had suggested that the college should provide more opportunities for personality development, including job/business-oriented teachings and industrial visits.	The IQAC Committee has directed the Academic Committee to align activities with these suggestions. Numerous activities were conducted during the 2022-2023 academic year.
2.	There are some Hindi medium students who do not understand complete English, so if the teachers will explain the concept in English as well as Hindi, then everyone will understand.	It has been suggested to the faculty that teaching in the classroom should be bilingual, incorporating both English and Hindi. This approach will ensure that all students, including those who are more comfortable with Hindi, can understand the content effectively.
3.	Students had suggested that the library should be stocked with more books in line with the new education policy syllabus.	The committee took action by instructing all coordinators to communicate with the academic faculty and gather the requirements for additional books in the library, aligning with the new education policy syllabus.
4.	Student suggested providing awareness about alternative careers and industry functioning, and forming clubs for participation in extracurricular activities and entrepreneurship.	The committee instructed the placement cell to take necessary actions accordingly. The placement cell had organized Job Fair at the end of the session.
5.	Skill development and job-oriented courses were requested	In response to the request for skill development and job-oriented courses, the college has taken action by signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) to offer a certification course. This collaboration aims to provide students with specialized training and certification in high-demand fields, enhancing their employability and career prospects.
