



Clean and Green Campus Policy

College is spread over a 15000 (approx.) sq. meter area has lush green sprawling campus. At the facade of college large sized trees like Anthocephalus, Callistemon, Tectona grandis, Delo-nix, Azedarach indica, Ficus spp., Phyllanthus, Terminalia arjuna, Polyantha longifolia, Cassia fistula etc. are growing from many years. The eco-friendly campus is extremely rich in flora.

1. Most of the trees are naturally grown and some of the trees, shrubs are planted to control pollution and for the beautification of the campus.
2. We grow plenty of herbs and medicinal plants in the campus, since a lot of them are used in practical, where we show them how to make herbal medicines.
3. There are many socio-economically valuable plants also grown in the campus.
4. Navgrah Vatika consisting of nine herbal plants which represents nine planets in celestial bodies is created in the campus. The combination of all nine herbal plants in a garden brings good health, prosperity and wealth. It holds cultural and spiritual significance, connecting people with ancient beliefs and traditions. It adds great value to our campus environment.
5. There are two small gardens in the campus with beautiful *flowers*. Flowering plants are like colourful paintings in nature, bringing joy and beauty to our world. Some amazing ones like Roses, Hibiscus, Tabernaemontara, Jatropha, Hamelia etc. ignite the inner positivity and bursts of joy. Beautiful fountain waterfall made out of waste by the students adds further life to the landscape.
6. Besides, this dense green flora is associated with some local fauna, beautiful and colourful butterflies, beetles, bees, ants and caterpillars etc. Every day the sun *shines* bright on the *plants* and pretty butterflies linger above the *flowers*. Some varieties of migrating birds like cranes land on the campus in late rainy season and give extra beautification to the campus. On the other hand, varieties of birds like woodpecker, owls, sparrows, pigeons, parrots, eagle, etc. regularly visit in search of food.
7. In view of recent demand on biodiversity conservation, the entire bio-rich campus was scanned to collect information of some flora and fauna in the form of data. Interestingly more

than 1225 plant species of trees, shrubs, hedges, grass, wild herbs and some birds, small animals and insects were present in the college campus.

8. To preserve the green cover on campus, college conducts regular sapling drives and initiatives involving faculty members and students
9. College management regularly takes care of natural resources the conservation of campus flora and fauna.
10. Number of other activities regarding the environment protection to be carried out along with the regular curriculum of the college.
11. In view of go green initiative, college fully focuses in multiplication of different types of tree species, plantlets and encourage students to plant a sapling on their birthday under the campaign रोपण संग आरोहण
12. The innovative practice of gifting a sapling to *dignitaries* visiting the campus promotes a greener way of living.
13. To celebrate important days such as world environment day, earth day etc.
