



WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICY 2021

College has a green campus and gives priority to keep the campus clean and eco-friendly. To maintain clean and green campus we nurture a culture of social responsibility and sustainability and seek to create environmentally conscious generation that is capable of steering the world towards a more sustainable future. The policy includes the following:

- Proper segregation of solid waste into different categories based on their characteristics, such as recyclability, biodegradability, and toxicity.
- The usage of plastic is prohibited on campus.
- Implement a comprehensive plastic recycling program on campus, with designated bins for collecting plastic waste
- Composting of garden waste and food waste from canteens.
- To establish a sustainability committee or task force dedicated to reducing plastic waste on campus.
- To develop a technology-centric educational and administrative strategy to reduce solid waste.
- To engage students in processing waste using 3Rs principle - Reduce, Reuse and Recycle, through innovative activities.
- To raise awareness among students on food waste and introduce good practices
- To minimize the usage of packaged foods, as well as the habit of reusing and recycling non-biodegradable items
- To organize solid waste management workshops for students.
- To collaborate with industries/ NGO's regarding recycling of plastics.
- Organizing awareness campaigns by NSS to reduce plastic use.
